



Corona Virus Update

April 2, 2020

On March 31, 2020, Governor Baker announced the extension of the state's stay at home advisory and mandated closure of nonessential businesses through May 4th. To comply with the Governor's advisory, Center for Living & working staff will continue to work remotely reaching out to consumers telephonically or via videophone through May 4th. We continue to take new referrals and will continue to provide the service you have come to expect from us.

On March 29, 2020, the Baker-Polito Administration launched the Buoy Health's online resource for residents to check their symptoms and connect with the appropriate health care resource. **Over the weekend, more than 14,200 people completed online interviews with the tool.** Buoy does not replace emergency medical care, but it may be used as a support for residents during the COVID-19 outbreak to connect them with appropriate health care resources if they display coronavirus symptoms. Buoy Health's online 24/7 tool is free for Massachusetts residents and uses current COVID-19 guidance from the CDC and Massachusetts Department of Public Health. To access go to www.bouyhealth.com
