WHEN WILL I GET MY CORONAVIRUS STIMULUS CHECK?

With the new IRS tool you can:

- See when your payment will be made to your account
- Add deposit/account information




NOTES

- Some people are not eligible for the stimulus payments.
- For those that are eligible, check amounts will be between:
 - \$1,200/per individual-\$2,400/per married couple filing jointly.
- Parents can get an additional \$500 per child under age 17.



EVICTIONS AND FORECLOSURES



On April 20, 2020 the state passed a law stopping **Evictions** or **home foreclosures** until the end of the COVID-19 state of emergency.

This means landlords can't:

- Evict tenants or ask them to leave
- Terminate/end apartment leases or home foreclosures

EXCEPTION: evictions due to criminal activity and Health & Safety lease violations.

- 1. The meeting/event you want to join
- 2. The request is for "Remote" services
- 3. How the meeting will take place (WebEx, Zoom, Microsoft team, etc.)

Once a request is in the system, MCDHH staff will contact the person who made the request with any questions.

<u>NOTE</u>: the person who makes the request must give all link/platform information to the Interpreter/CART.


