
# Governor Baker's COVID-19 Updates

#### Market Basket - Mobile Vaccination Clinics

June 10th—12th (Thursday, Friday and Saturday)

Vaccine clinics will be at *Market Basket* in: Chelsea, Fall River, Lawrence, Lynn, Revere.



All individuals 12 and older who live, work or study in Massachusetts can get a vaccine.



#### Mass vaccination sites will close:

- Gillette Stadium: June 14
- Hunes Convention Center: June 22
- Natick Mall: June 23
- *Reggie Lewis Center*: June 27
- Doubletree in Danvers: June 30
- Eastfield Mall in Springfield: July 6
- Former Circuit City in Dartmouth: July 13




# **USDA Approves State Plan for Summer P-EBT**

#### Did your K-12 student get P-EBT this school year?

They will get a total of \$375 in P-EBT benefits in 2 payments:

- 1st payment: July 1 \$187.50
- 2nd payment: **August 1** \$187.50



#### Does your family get SNAP and did you get P-EBT this year for children ages 0-6?

They will get a total of \$375 in P-EBT benefits in 2 payments:

- 1st payment: July 25 \$187.50
- 2nd payment: **August 25** \$187.50
