



## **State-Funded Extra SNAP Payments**

Due to the end of Federal COVID SNAP benefits and rising food costs, Massachusetts will provide 3 more SNAP benefits. These state-funded extra SNAP payments will arrive on: April 7, May 2, and June 2, 2023.

#### Payments will be:

- a minimum amount of \$38 a month and
- *up to* 40% of the difference between *your household's maximum benefit amount for your household size* and *your regular monthly benefit amount*.

#### You may qualify for an increase in benefits <u>if</u>:

- Someone in your SNAP household (age 60 or older, or has a disability) pays \$35/month for medical costs,
- Your housing costs (rent/mortgage) have gone up, and
- You're working, looking for work, or in school **and** have child or disabled adult care costs.

#### Tell DTA about any changes by:

- Uploading information on the free mobile app or online portal DTA Connect,
- Call the DTA Assistance Line at: 877-382-2363,
- Visit a local DTA office (<u>https://www.mass.gov/orgs/department-of-transitional-assistance/locations</u>),
- Work with a <u>SNAP outreach partner</u>.







