


# Free COVID-19 At-Home Test Kits by Mail!

Every U.S. household can now place an order to get **4** free COVID-19 rapid tests sent directly to your home.

- Limit: 1 order per residential address
- 1 order includes 4 individual rapid antigen COVID-19 tests

(<u>COVIDTests.gov</u> has more details about at-home tests, including extended shelf life and updated expiration dates).



### **STOP MEDICARE FRAUD**

Follow these 3 tips to protect yourself from scammers:

- Don't respond if you get a call, text or email asking for your Medicare Number.
- · Check your Medicare statements, notices and claims carefully.
- · Suspect fraud? Report it!

**Updated 10/3/2023** 

- Everyone aged 5 years and older should get 1 dose of the updated Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna COVID-19 vaccine to protect against serious illness from COVID-19.
- <u>People who are moderately or severely</u>
   <u>immunocompromised</u> may get **additional** doses of updated COVID-19 vaccine.
- <u>Children aged 6 months-4 years</u> need multiple doses of COVID-19 vaccines to be *up to date*, including at least 1 dose of updated COVID-19 vaccine.
